Academy of Natural Sciences, Philadelphia

The Academy of Natural Sciences, Philadelphia, will host an international symposium on cyanobacteria entitled "Cyanobacterial Research: Recent Advances, Research Needs and Management Implications," to be held 16–20 April 1989. Topics in the symposium include all aspects of cyanobacterial research, from molecular biology, physiology, and ecology through applied research on control of nuisance algae in aquatic habitats. Abstracts will be reviewed and 10 selected for poster presentation at the symposium; manuscripts will be included in publication of the final proceedings. Due to space limitations at the symposium, participation will be by invitation only.
